Range Briefing

COLD RANGE

Detroit Sportsmen Congress is a cold range. Do not handle firearms except in the designated SAFE AREAS or under the direct supervision of a designated Range Officer. Handling firearms in the parking areas is deemed unsafe gun handling and subject to immediate match disqualification.

SAFE AREAS

There are 4 safe areas located around the outdoor range. (See range map for locations). The safe areas are used to bag, unbag, holster, or unholster firearms and may also be used for dry fire practice and gun repair. No ammunition may be handled in any safe area. The safe areas include a foot-fault box surrounding the safe table in which you must be standing to be considered in the safe area.

MATCH RULES

The match rules that will be used are found online at the www.uspsa.org website. They are the 2019 USPSA Competition Rules Effective January 1, 2019.

Range Briefing

MATCH OFFICIALS

RO's, CRO's, and other match staff are here to assist you in completing the course of fire in a safe manner. If at any time during a course of fire you hear "Stop" immediately cease fire with the muzzle pointing safely down range, finger outside of the trigger guard, safety on, and wait for further instruction.

EVERYONE HELPS

In order to keep the match moving smoothly competitors are expected to assist in pasting targets and resetting steel as directed by the stage RO's.

LOST BRASS

All brass will be collected by the range officers at the conclusion of each days shooting in consideration for their hard work.

SCHEDULING

All competitors are expected to compete for score according to the published match squadding schedule. A competitor who is not present at the scheduled time for any stage may not attempt that stage without prior approval of the Match Director without which the competitors score will be zero. Competitors may not "skip ahead" to shoot on an empty stage unless specifically directed to do so by the Match Director.

Range Briefing

STAGE BRIEFINGS AND INSPECTIONS

At the scheduled time the entire squad will be assembled and a brief stage walk-through will be given followed by a 5-minute inspection and question/answer period. Shooters may negotiate obstacles only during the 5-minute inspection period. Only the on-deck competitor may negotiate obstacles while the previous competitor's targets are being scored. Early inspection is permitted only if a squad is not currently on the course of fire. Targets or activators may not be operated during an early inspection. If the RO staff is present on an empty stage please extend them the courtesy of asking permission before inspecting the course of fire.

SHOOTER READINESS

Competitors are expected to be ready to load and make ready quickly when called to the line. Shooters not ready within a 30 second prep time may be asked to move aside for the next competitor. Any shooter not ready when their name is called will be moved to the bottom of the shooting order.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION

All competitors must wear eye and ear protection while on the firing line. Eye protection is required to be worn by everyone while on the range. A hat with a brim is recommended to be worn at all times.

Range Briefing

CHRONOGRAPH

Competitors sample ammunition will be pulled at their first stage. The chronograph station will be after Stage 8. Please remain on Stage 8 to help reset the stage until your squad is complete unless directed otherwise by then CRO.

MATCH SCORING

PractiScore will be used for electronic collection of competitor scores. After the competitor has completed a stage the competitor will review the scoring summary provided on the scoring device. The competitor will then “sign” the score sheet by pressing the “Accept” button on the scoring device. If for any reason a competitor refuses to accept the score the matter will be referred to the Range Master as required by rule 9.7.3. Competitors can take a photograph of the scoring summary page as their personal record as this will be a paperless match. Scores will be posted to the www.practiscore.com website multiple times per day.

RANGE FACILITIES

Rest Room

Portable toilets are located around the outside range. There are also facilities in the shotgun range building as well as the clubhouse where registration is located.

Lunch is included with your match fee and will be served at the range and is scheduled to start at 12:45 PM or after the squad shoots their fifth stage.

Parking

Competitor parking will be on the south side of Juengel Road. (see facility map).

Spectators are welcome and must wear eye and ear protection while on the range. Climbing on berms is not allowed.

START POSITION: Standing with toes touching either marks, handgun is loaded and holstered, hand below belt. PCC standing with toes touching either marks, carbine loaded with safety on, top of stock touching belt, barrel pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

At start signal, engage targets as they become visible from within the Free Fire Zone.

Off-Limits area marked by the red box. Any opening within that box are considered RO pass throughs.


