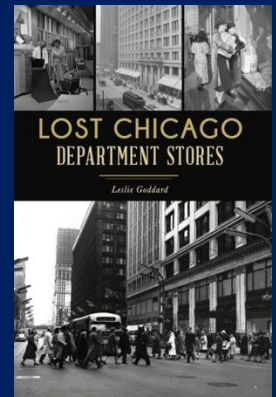




LOST CHICAGO DEPARTMENT STORES
