Why are my POA dues increasing?

Due to inflationary costs and aged infrastructure, the POA has been operating at a loss the past few years, resulting in a reduction in reserve funds. Since the POA's incorporation in 2005, dues have never been increased despite the rising costs to upkeep aging infrastructure.

Who decided this and When?

After the treasury report was given at the annual POA meeting, a member present suggested increasing the dues. The Board underwent a financial assessment evaluating the budget and forecasting future large expenses (such as a new Clubhouse roof, repairing pool deck foundation, and replacing irrigation).
