Starting Lane Pairings

The 6-game Haynes Bowling Supply (HBS) Challenge Qualifying Round is scheduled for Thursday, November 14 at 10:00 AM on the 43' pattern. Haynes Bowling Supply and Logo Infusion have generously added \$3,000 to the Haynes Bowling Supply Challenge Prize Fund. 32 players plus the next 8 Super Seniors advance to the HBS Match Play Round. A total of 53 players, including 10 Super Seniors, cash. Pinfall from the Qualifying Round is carried over.

Lanes WILL NOT be re-oiled prior to the 5-game HBS Match Play round which will begin at 4:15 PM. The Stepladder Finals will begin as soon as possible once the Match Play round has been completed, the stepladder finalists have been determined, and finals lanes are re-oiled. Roll call will be conducted 30 minutes prior to the start time of the Qualifying Round and 15 minutes prior to the Match Play Round. Last year +70 (+35 for SS) advanced to the Match Play round.
