



Patrick, Director

- Patrick showed the survey results. You can view the results on the following slides 6-11.
- Everyone who took the survey said they enjoyed the Block Party, everyone met new neighbors which was one of the top things they liked most about the Block Party, most people thought the party was good, and all said they would likely attend next year
- Additional feedback for next year: need more volunteers, planning should start in spring, need garbage cans or dumpster in the beginning, need to purchase less or different food, need better speakers, need a budget prior to planning.
- · \$429 deficit which is in line with the other years possibly due to inflation and more variety of foods purchased.



Did you enjoy the Trinity Creeks Block Party on Saturday August 27?



Did you meet any new neighbors? If yes, how many?








Would you like to attend the end of the year Trinity Creeks HOA Holiday Party in December? (adults only)

Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions – Trinity Creeks Subdivision Matteson, IL Article V, 5b

Purpose and Use of Assessments: All assessments levied by the Board shall be for the purpose of insuring high standards of maintenance, repair and replacement of the entrance signage monument and adjoining landscaping. Such purposes and uses of such assessment shall include (but are not limited to) the costs of the Association of all legal, insurance, repair, replacement, maintenance and other charges by this Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, or that the Board of Directors of the Association shall determine to be necessary or desirable to meet the primary purpose of the Association.
