Revision of the Proposed New Class of Membership: Legacy Member

D. Class 4 Legacy Membership: At the age of 21 a Legacy Membership can be proposed for an individual whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing. The first year's membership of the proposed Legacy member will be **free of charge with no initiation fee.** The following conditions apply: Application must be filled out to provide or update sponsoring member's information and the application must have approval of the Board, then proposed to the membership for approval.

Application process should begin two months prior to birthday month as the membership procedure takes 60 days, therefore, it would be completed by the 21st birthday. If Legacy's birthday is late in the year, the application process should begin in August, therefore the legacy year will carry through the following calendar year. The Legacy membership card will be significantly different from general membership to show Legacy membership distinction. The Legacy year is considered the first year of membership and will count toward tenure if followed by continuous annual membership fee renewal.

This will presented to the Membership at the July 11th Membership Meeting for a vote.
