

The Shane Farrell Memorial Scholarship

The Shane Farrell Memorial Scholarship has been established in memory of Shane Farrell, a 7th grade student at Qualters Middle School, who was tragically taken from us too soon. Shane was a lively, humorous, creative, and sociable young boy who cared about serving others. His creativity with story-telling through video production and dedication to community service was funny and inspiring to so many.

Two scholarships will be offered to two deserving Mansfield High School seniors who will be attending either a trade school or a two or four-year institution.

The two scholarships are for Creativity and Good Citizenship.

The Creative scholarship will be awarded to a student who's video creation (online only via YouTube or Vimeo) for this year's theme of "Shanged for Good" gets the most votes from the panel of judges. The video of "Shanged for Good" must be 30 seconds to no more than 2 minutes long, be positive and demonstrate in some way how you were changed for the better due to someone in your life's influence. The video can be serious, funny or creative – but must be age appropriate. Your video, whether awarded the scholarship or not, may be used on the scholarship fund's website or social media pages.*

The Good Citizenship scholarship will be awarded to a student has demonstrated a willingness to give back to others. This person must be nominated by a fellow student, teacher and or community leader. This person must have demonstrated the following characteristics: Leadership, compassion, inspiration, determination, fair play.*

For both of these awards the submissions must be in keeping with good judgement and project nothing of violence, inappropriate language, criminal activity, sexuality, exploitation of animals, or any other content deemed objectionable by the scholarship and or its judges.

- Accepted to and planning to attend a trade school, or 2 or 4-year college/university

- Applicants must submit with their application, an essay, between 500-750 words, on how community service and good citizenship has played a part in their daily lives.
- Submission subject matter must be in keeping with good judgement and project nothing of violence, inappropriate language, criminal activity, sexuality, exploitation of animals, or any other content deemed objectionable by the scholarship fund and/or its judges.*
