




## FLCA NEWSLETTER SPECIAL FEATURE:

### A PERSONAL ACCOUNT AT THE SSSC / May 25-June 3, 2012

For those of you who have not been to Switzerland a little bit of an overview of the area serves to give a picture of the environment in which one finds the Semjase Silver Star Center (SSSC) situated. I have not been to other parts of Switzerland, however, the area north of Zurich where the SSSC is located is beautiful. Rolling hills stretch off

into the distance like a vast quilt stitched in squares of all hues of green; wooded copses giving away to rolling fields. On a clear day the majestic Alps can be seen bordering the horizon. Below is Jimmy Chen. [left]

When one comes off the highway leading from the Zurich airport you find yourself on little two lane winding roads that pass through little villages where the building fronts are literally four feet from the street. The farmland is ordered, neat and well kept. Crops are planted in precise, straight rows. Even the newer 'suburbs' are not an affront to the eye,

unlike Canada where cookie cutter monster homes consume the land. Here the new homes are built in an efficient manner with an eye to small ecological footprints. The older village homes are quaint and decorative in a typical Swiss style. Gas prices, I noticed, were around 1.85 a litre. Compared to Canadian prices these days of 1.21 a litre there is a significant difference. Concomitantly the majority of cars are small and efficient as well. Absent are hummers, vans, SUVs. The train and bus network is also incredibly efficient, punctual and well planned serving villages and towns near and far.


The last part of the 45 min journey from the Zurich airport finds us on a road that slowly winds itself up a vast incline, with the road switching back again and again. This takes about 10 minutes. Finally we've arrived. Normally we'd park in the visitors parking lot from where one takes a short stroll down a little dirt road set into the side of a steep hill going sharply up on your right and down into a valley on the left. This road is like walking along a path through a forest glen where one comes shortly to the two main buildings that are the heart of the SSSC.

**ATTENTION TO THE MOMENT OF DEPARTURE FROM CONCENTRATION**

Whenever I sit down to meditate on my breath, or partake in any other meditation goal, inevitably a distraction slips in, and before you know it, a symphony of thoughts, images, connecting events, past events, daydreams, feelings etc., carry me on a meandering journey, far removed from my original goal. How sly is this process of thinking that lures me, seduces me with every trick in the book and how quick I am to give in to these temptations. Finally, once I have had enough of this and realise my predicament, I resolve to get back on track. The question is, how long did it take to recognise this divergence and could I have avoided this wide detour back to my original goal which is, essentially, to quiet and calm the thought process in order to fully be concentrated on the object of meditation. So the challenge is to remain fully aware in the moment where the future flows into the past, and the instant the distraction appears, is the moment that might-oriented thinking is applicable. Without suppression, the thought process and all its connections are simply put aside for the time being for this is not appropriate in order to achieve the concentration of attention. The key is the immediate recognition of the moment of deviation and the immediate recovery to the concentration.

Recognise the moment thought is stepping in, apply might-oriented thinking, return to the concentration. Inevitably the frequency of distraction diminishes and the quality of concentration improves. This means building up the will to concentrate.

**How did you come across the Billy Meier material?**

One day, I think in the spring of 2008, I came across a website (ufoevidence.org) with a large archive of UFO photos while I was doing research on UFOs because at that time, the mysteries surrounding their presence made me quite curious. I browsed through them chronologically from newest to oldest. The photos at the beginning were blurry, not clear, showing a speck in the sky or did not lead anywhere, etc. I didn't have

too much expectation since I thought the older photos were not going to get any better, until I came across some of the most clear photos of UFOs from the 1970's. These at first seemed too good to be true and as if the photographer must have made previous arrangements because the UFOs were actually posing for these photos. The possibility of them being small models were also in my mind but at the same time, there were other photos that would show otherwise; for example, UFOs next to large objects like trees. Then, I found out that these photos were taken by "Billy" Meier.

**What lead you to become a part of FIGU?**

After finding the photos, I searched for "Billy" Meier's name through the Internet and this lead to more information pertaining to the case, such as photos, sound recordings, film footages, metal sample analyses, interviews, contact information and spiritual teachings. There was always more to find out because the evidence was so abundant and was also based on very solid foundations such as credible witnesses, researchers and scientists. with our present world, despite its unworldly nature, it gradually clarified many mysteries in diverse areas. Somehow the evidence, the behaviour of the pilots that wanted to reveal themselves but at the same time did not want to overstep their boundaries and Billy's honest character all resonated well and led me to a very convincing conclusion that this was most likely the truth. If this was the truth I thought, then what these ET presence (Plejarens) were trying to show us, e.g., the state of our world, the dangers and possible ways to remediate them, are likely to be based on the truth. In early 2009, I became a part of FIGU and in the Fall of 2010, met the FIGU Canadian Landesgruppe for the first time in a public meeting at Don's house.

**What do you hope to achieve with being a part of FIGU?**

I hope to contribute to making the information from this case available for anyone who would be interested in it. For me, FIGU has always represented the truth, so I would like to stand by the truth and support it whenever possible.

**What does the spiritual-based information mean to you?**

on the media presence of FIGU. Bernadette Brand reported on new writings and publications. Thereafter, reports were presented by, or on behalf of, the various Landesgruppen, followed by study groups, from around the world. A lunch break was taken and then a musical interlude was made by Rosa Klotz as she played and sang along with her accordion. Christian Frehner presented a report from Michael Horn of his activities in Brazil and his return to L.A. Christian Krukowski read from Billy's recently published article: Meditation über den Tod ist wichtig (Meditation on Death is Important). Simone Rickauer answered questions submitted by passive members. Christian showed a video of life at SSSC circa late 1980's. It was fun to see everyone so much younger and the center in its earlier state. Stephan Rickauer moderated a general question and answer session. Andreas then wrapped up the meeting and bid us farewell until next year.

This however necessitates, primarily, that one distinguishes between the male and female brains, because in truth, actually, enormous differences exist because the two brains deviate considerably from one another in their working- and effectiveness-structures. If one examines the anatomy of the brain of small children, then it becomes recognizable, that with boys, these are decidedly larger than with girls. This also remains so until into adulthood, whereby men show approximately 100 grams more brain matter than women. However, in contrast to the male's brain, the female's is denser and therefore more compact. Contrary to the brain of the man, that of the woman contains, consequently, up to 14% more nerve cells in different areas. Contrastingly, the brain of the man shows more nerve cells than the woman in only just one area, and indeed, in the Hypothalamus. This cherry-stone-sized structure, however, is the place of drives and not the center of thoughts or the consciousness-based abilities and possibilities. The two autonomous brain parts of the human being are connected by a cord that is also known as the corpus callosum in the terrestrial science of anatomy. With the female gender, this connecting cord is up to 34 percent larger than that of the man, which is why the woman can better simultaneously use both her brain hemispheres. Observing and considering the feelings of man and woman, then it is to be noted that these clearly yield the most diverse values. With the woman, the so-called upper limbic system is of great significance because in this she processes most trains of thought. The feelings of the woman are situated in this system and for example, also motherly love. This part of the brain is most highly developed in this form and such is only found in the human being as well as in the ape. With the man, in contrast to the woman, the lower limbic system is almost alone responsible for thinking. This is also responsible for vital functions such as, for example, the perception of cold-warm. Likewise, it is also responsible for the control of aggression and sexuality. This part of the brain of the male is already very old and a remnant from primeval times, millions of years ago. Alone, already through the anatomical differences of the brains of man and woman, the forms of perceptions as well as thoughts, feelings and deeds differ with respect to the male and female. So it is given, for example, that the woman can hear, see, smell and taste very much better than the man. The world of the man is that of aggression and drives, whereas the woman is very much more oriented on quiet balance, peace, profound feelings and feelings for others, as well as on connecting relationships and their content. What appears as particular with the brain of the woman is the circumstance that this shrinks during pregnancy. However, the perception capability and thinking, as well as her social capabilities and attitudes, policies and endeavours, suffer no harm because of it. This fact of the shrinking of the female brain during pregnancies means no intellectual time advantage for the male gender however, because the man also falls prey to a similar process. Namely, actually beginning at 45 years of age, his brain also shrinks whereby also the capabilities becomes adversely affected. This quite visibly dwindles, and indeed in irrevocable form. The different temperaments are determined by hormones.

Through the precisely measured outflow/injection of male and female hormones it is already determined in the womb, in which

clearance to grow. That was hard work on what seemed to be, a 60 degree incline (but was probably closer to 45)!



quantity the emergent human being, after his birth, owns male and/or female characteristics and behaviours, etc.[1] The female hormone estrogen leads to it that the person becomes more peaceful and more social, whereas the male testosterone makes one ready to take risks, more aggressive and dominant. Together with the hormonal influences, three further factors become evident which cause determining differences between man and woman, and indeed, in the form of equal rights and equality. As a rule, the woman is lacking great physical powers as well as Gewalt[2] and such things, because from time immemorial she has been the guardian of social and human cohesion, whereas the man, from time immemorial, used his power in order to hunt, to fight, to rule and to survive adventures, whereby aggressions and drives along with Gewalt were his constant companions. member by saying "Salome" with his enchanting smile. Beginning our ten days visit, Jimmy, Catherine and I represented the FIGU-Landesgruppe Canada. Willem Mondria graciously picked us up from the Zurich airport, and later, took us on a day trip to Winterthur. As new arrivals at SSSC, the introductions started immediately, first with Christian Frehner as he drove up towards us on a blue tractor transporting metal rods, then international passive group members (PGM), from Holland, Italy, and Bosnia, in this order.

As we were unloading our camping gear from Willem's car, at approximately 3:00 pm, everyone stopped working for a beverage break, most converging in the kitchen for refreshments. The greetings continued with the members from Bulgaria, Austria, Sweden, Japan, Germany and USA as well as the CGM; there were just too many members to list them all.

At the center, I witnessed FIGU members who were always busy, preparing for upcoming events such as the Annual General Passive Group Meeting on Saturday, painting, maintaining the firewood or making dinner which is served promptly at 5:30 pm. The organization and the grounds of the center are impeccably clean.

Andreas, the president of the core group stated that, to date, there are 306 international PGMs. Over one hundred of the members united on Saturday May 26, in a small town called Bichelsee, a 20 minute drive from the SSSC. The Annual General Passive Group Meeting started at 10:00 am and finished at 5:30 pm. International passive group members and core-group members reported the development of global FIGU activities for the past year and their future plans, ideas and projects for Earth's humanity. All the presentations are spoken in German. With my limited understanding of German, what I gathered from the meeting is that the Internet plays an important part in bringing FIGU members together.

Monday May 28, being a Christian holiday, our work at the center did not start until Tuesday. For the next five days from 10:00 am to 5:30 pm we were on the steep forest slope weeding around the newly planted trees and cutting the grass, with the occasional belly slides down the hill with much laughter when one of us lost our footing on the steep slope. 
