

Weil Ware Pottery

Brenda shared her collection of Celadon Rose Weil Ware Pottery. It was produced by Weil of California (1946-1955). It comes in variations of floral, bamboo, and mango with colors in celadon, grey, yellow, pink, and cream. All hand painted. The edges on squared plates and saucers are rounded and the sides of square or rectangle bowls are slightly curved giving the pottery an distinctive look.

She showed us three examples of the Weil manufacturer's stamps. The first paper stamp using MWC for Max Weil. The other two incorporating a donkey which represented Dopey, the factory pet that wandered around freely at the factory.
