

Shelia W. Howey Scholarship Program

Section VII: SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

1. The Bead Society shall establish a scholarship fund for members. The fund will be named the Shelia W. Howey Memorial Scholarship Fund and will be funded by the sale of tickets from the Annual Bead Jar and by donations. The fund will be administered as outlined in these rules.
2. The Scholarship fund will be used for members attendance at classes offered by or sponsored by affiliate members or sponsored by the Southern Colorado Bead Society (annual bead gathering).
3. Awards are limited to one-half the tuition cost of a single class and shall not exceed \$50.00 per member per class. The tuition cost of the class is the instruction portion. Awards shall be payable by check to the affiliate where the member will attend class. Up to two awards may be granted in any calendar quarter but in no event shall two awards be granted to one member in that same quarter.
4. To be eligible for consideration, members must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Have been a member for one year prior to application.
 - b. Have attended and signed in for at least two general membership meetings prior to application.
 - c. Complete and sign an application which includes a short essay describing how the member will benefit by attending the specific class.
 - d. Did not receive scholarship funds in the immediate six months prior to application.
5. Committee decisions shall be final and not subject to appeal.
