The June 28th meeting, the State Representative Steve Marino, District 25(Harrison Twp.) will be at our meeting. Let's try and give him a full house.

SB0046: *Revise emergency vehicle flashing lights requirement*—allows emergency vehicles to have flashing lights somewhere on the vehicle; not necessarily on the roof of the vehicle. Passed by the full House & returned to the Senate on 5-3-2017. It was presented to the Governor on 5-16-17, and he was expected to sign it on 5-25-2017. Bill given immediate effect, so will be in effect once governor signs.

SB0160 (also HB4525): *Definition of Autocycle*—Passed full Senate, sent to house. Read in House for the first time, and then referred to House Transportation & Infrastructure Committee on 4-19-2017.

New Legislation:

HB4633: *Allow for 2-year vehicle registration*-- Introduced by Steven Johnson (sponsor) on 5-25-2017. Referred to Transportation & Infrastructure Committee.
