We had a blast at Roche Harbor; many thanks to Bob and Linda for a great dinner. The weather could not have been better. So nice to see everyone that came out for this.

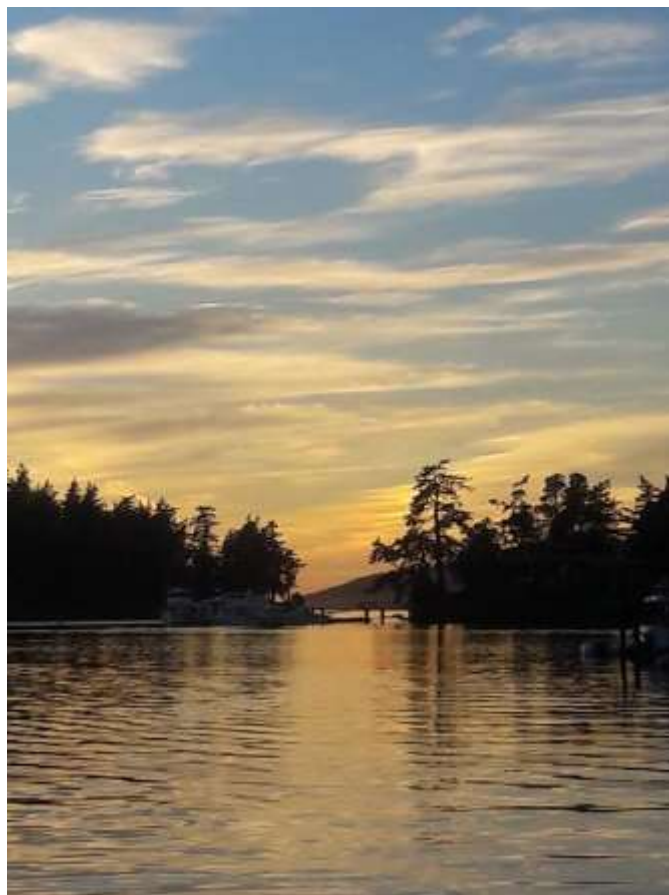
Mary and I had a great two weeks in the islands. The crabbing was really good. We ate crab for days.
