

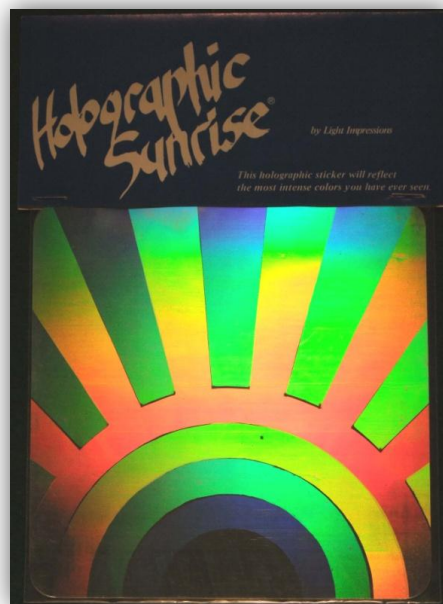

Embossed holograms and special products with holograms (more to be added)

There is a very large amount of embossed holograms produced since the technique was invented in the early 1980s. The main application of them has been in document security applications but also in advertising and product promotions. Among all of them there are a few which stand out. They may be very large ones, very beautiful ones, embossed holograms by artists, for example. Here are some which may be of interest to people interested in holograms.



Holographic Sunrise (1982)

Silver-backed embossed hologram

Hologram by *Steve McGrew*, USA

Size: 8" x 8" (20 x 20 cm) **£25.-**

Steve McGrew at *Light Impressions* in the USA started the embossed hologram industry in the early 1980s. He produced many stock holograms sold through the new hologram galleries which appeared during the same time around the world. Soon companies in Europe started also producing embossed holograms. The *Holographic Sunrise* was one such an embossed hologram which was one of the best selling products on the market.



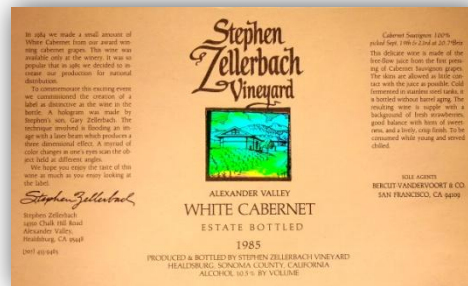
Tiffen (1982)

Silver-backed embossed hologram

Hologram by **Jody Burns**, USA

Framed, size: 8" x 10" (20 x 25 cm) **£75.-**

This hologram was produced for **Tiffen Company** and was, at that time, one of the largest-size embossed holograms. A total of 10000 holograms were produced for about 5000 camera shops in the USA. According to Jody Burns only 50% of the production run resulted in acceptable holograms.



Zellerbach White Cabernet Label (1985)

Silver-backed embossed hologram

Hologram size: 1" x 1½" (2.5 x 3.2 cm) **Label: £10.- Wine bottle with label: £45.-**

Gary Zellerbach opened one of the first hologram galleries in the world in February 1979, the **Holos Gallery** in San Francisco. His father who owned Stephen Zellerbach Vineyard, Alexander Valley, in California introduced a wine label with an embossed hologram, which was probably the first hologram label on a wine bottle. The hologram was designed by Gary and Light Impressions was responsible for the holographic foil. A printer overprinted the picture of the vineyard and grapes on the labels and cut them into tiny squares. They were hand applied to the wine labels.



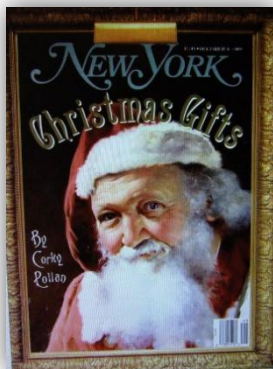

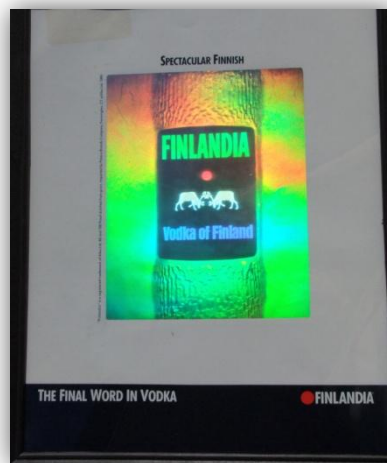

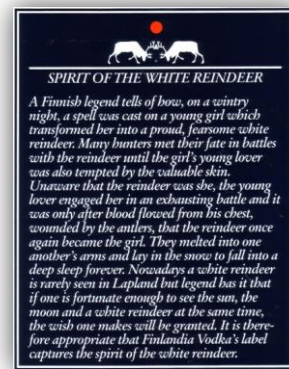

The Finlandia Vodka advertisement was made up of a two-page insert in the *New York Magazine*, Volume 22, No. 48, December 4, 1989. The *Spectacular Finnish* hologram was on page 83 and on page 84 was the "The White Reindeer" famous Finnish folktale. The model for the hologram was made by holographer *Ken Harries* who painted the outside of it to create the characteristic cracked ice appearance. To get the two reindeers to appear white in the hologram, multiple overlapping rainbow holograms were recorded.

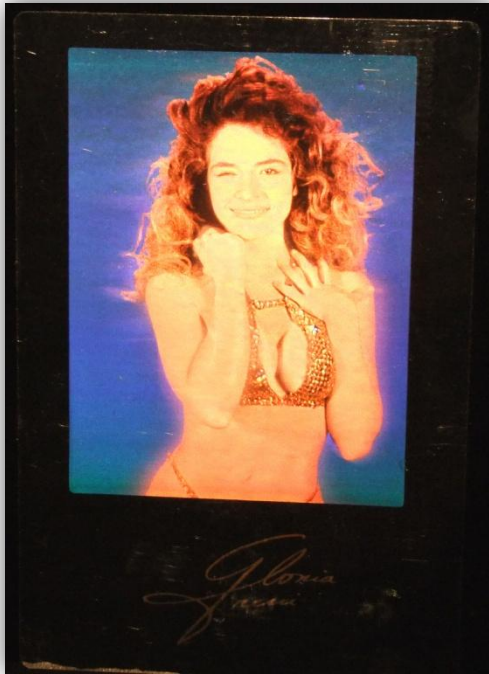

3D Kalachakra Mandala Hologram (2011)

The Tibetan word for Mandala is *kyilkor*, which means "center and surrounding environment." The Mandala of a tantric deity [in this case, the Buddhist deity, Kalachakra] includes the deity and his palace, which is also a representation of the mind of the deity. Based on symbols familiar to the people of India during the Buddha's lifetime, each Mandala is a pictorial manifestation of a tantra. It may be "read" and studied as a text, memorized for visualization during meditation, and interpreted.

Usually drawn in sand as a flat disc, the kalachakra (sometimes spelled Kalakakra) Mandala is visualized in the mind of the meditator as a 3D structure. There are 1,620 deities in the full Mandala, plus numerous architectural elements, etc., making it perhaps the most complex system of esoteric Buddhism. Each deity has a specific meaning and they are contemplated in a specific order, thus purifying the mind of the meditator and leading to enlightenment in this body. Tibetan monks used to spend up to twenty years to master this Mandala system, its accompanying cycle of texts, and secret oral instructions. The Kalachakra Mandala holograms used for the special cards have been blessed by His Holiness the Dalai Lama.

This animated hologram was issued as a limited-edition of 100 nickel plates signed by the artist. The hologram was also included in the Ten*8 photographic journal in 1993. This hologram is a normal embossed hologram and not signed by the artist.

The holographic stereogram portrait used for the coin and the stamp was the 'Equanimity' portrait (meaning 'the quality of being calm and even-tempered') recorded in 2004 by the artist *Chris Levine* and holographer *Rob Munday*. The holographic portrait of *Her Majesty-The Queen* was commissioned by Jersey Heritage Trust as part of the island's celebrations which took place 2004, marking 800 years of Jersey's heritage of continuous loyalty to the Crown. For the portrait The Queen wore a string of white pearls and the Diamond Diadem, created for King George IV and worn by Her Majesty for the procession to her Coronation. The lenticular medal was issued 2006 to celebrate the Queen's Eighties Birthday. The obverse features the Equanimity portrait and the reverse by Harry Brockway depicts the supporters from the Royal arms and St Edward's Crown.

To celebrate Queen Elisabeth II's Diamond Jubilee a £10 holographic definitive hologram stamp with the 'Equanimity' portrait of was issued by Jersey post on 1 June 2012. The £10 postage stamp features a unique 3D achromatic b/w digital embossed stereogram hologram portrait. The value and lettering on the stamp has been produced in flat simili silver foiling. The hologram for the stamp was created especially for Jersey Post by Rob Munday. The stamps were printed by Cartor Security Printing in France in sheetlets of four (2 across x 2 down).

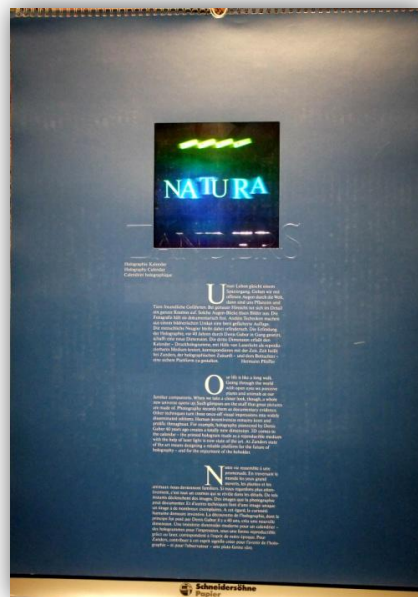

Calendars

There are several calendars issued with embossed holograms over many years. However the most unique and beautiful calendar was the **NATURA** Calendar issued in **1988** by **Zanders Feinpapier AG** in Germany. This calendar is an example of innovative creative techniques. Holography and computer graphics are juxtaposed to photography and free artistic reprehensions. Embossing in combination with gloss and matt varnishing refine the picture motifs and endow them with an aesthetic appeal of unobtrusive elegance. A dialogue is initiated as a result of this direct comparison of techniques. For example, the holographic rose on the January sheet is not the same as the photographic rose or in blind relief embossing – and yet they had one and the same rose as their model. The calendar sheets are printed on high quality fine papers by Zanders. The holograms were produced by **Fred Unterseher** at Holocom, Kakendorf, Germany. Computer graphics was generated by CPM, Düsseldorf. The calendar was produced by Wolfgang Witte at Zanders on CROMOLUX paper and carton. The even surface CHROMOLUX was selected as suitable carrier material for embossed holograms.

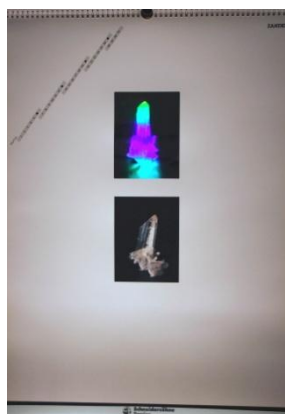

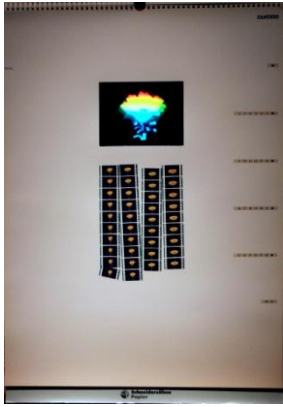

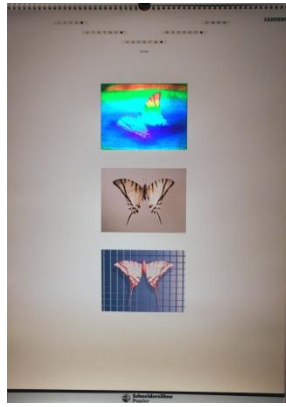

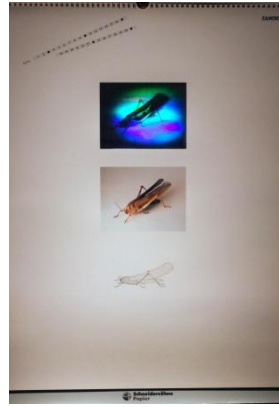

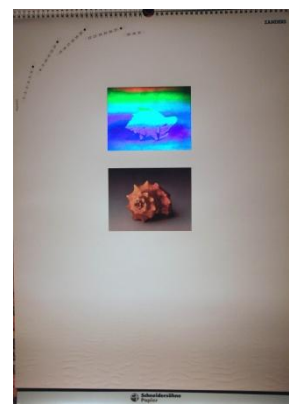

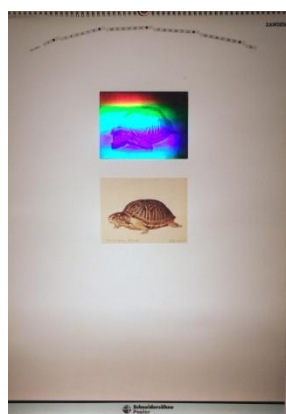

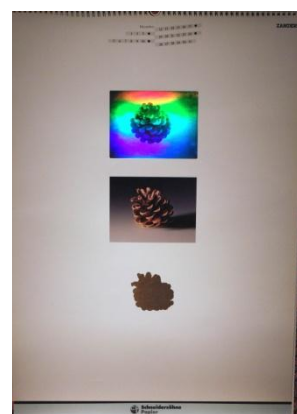

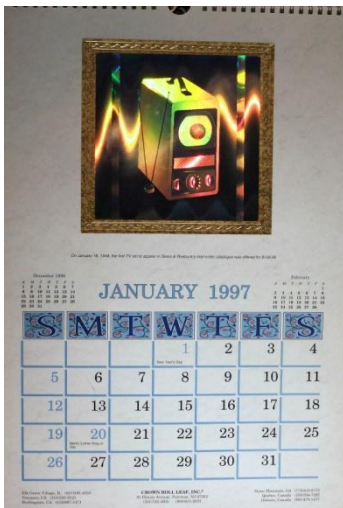
