When Weiser is done, Joe Michelini, our attorney, will question his testimony. Planning Board has 45 days to make a yea or nay recommendation to the Council.

The Council will then have 30 days to give their decision. Then it will go to court...Berkeley will surely appeal to the appellate court if the judge votes in our favor. We will have the same option if we lose.

There was a question and answer period.

Don asked about making a parking lot on 20th instead of single family homes.

Members were asked to talk to new neighbors about our organization and quest.
