Albert John Buerker, age 72 of Pigeon, passed away Saturday, July 27 at McLaren Hospital in Flint.

He was born in Pigeon on June 23, 1924, the son of the late Albert Fred and Emma C. (Maier) Buerker. He was a self-employed farrier, working throughout Michigan with various county fairs and horse racing arenas, although basing his business in Montrose.
