

Typical Teaching Schedule

Most AETs teach at one or two elementary schools, but never at both in the same day. Here is an example of how an AET's weekly schedule might look, if he/she teaches at two elementary schools:

Monday: school 1

Tuesday: school 2

Wednesday: school 2

Thursday: kindergarten/nursery school; school 1

Friday: school 1

- Our "main" elementary school (for those of us who teach at two) is the school we go to on Mondays. It is at our main elementary schools that we must request vacation time, address any issues we might have, and generally take part in school activities (like "sports festival day", graduation ceremonies etc.)
- Typically, bi-monthly, you will teach at a kindergarten or 1-2 nursery schools in addition to our regular schools. On such days, we usually go directly to our assigned kindergarten/nursery school in the morning and then return to our main school for lunch/afternoon work.
- By the way, the nursery schools/kindergartens we teach at remain the same throughout the year.
- At elementary schools, AETs teach grades 1-6.
- At kindergarten, we typically teach a younger and an older class (ages 4-5 and 5-6, respectively).
- At nursery schools, you typically teach one class of older students, age 5-6.
- Some AETs teach at Jr. high schools. In most cases, new AETs will be assigned to teach at elementary schools, *not* at Jr. highs.
