Cost for sidewalks on Vance Ave, W. Draper Street, and N. Orchard Blvd. \$41,504. Budget for project is \$40,000. FG United Methodist church donated \$1,000 to this project. SW Construction building Kum & Go donated piping for the sidewalk project. Roe contacted MIRMA Insurance and Greene County about box culvert and round pipe concerns that came up at last Board meeting. Both advised to take steps to make box culvert/round pipe safe with chain link fence or barrier. Additional cost for box culvert and concrete work for storm water will come from budgeted line item for storm water improvements. Icenhower wants MoDot to stake easements on N. Orchard Blvd.

Hokanson discussed overlay project. Manhole risers have been ordered. Paving Swan Street from Cottonwood to Cedar Street will fall within budgeted amount.


Motion by Icenhower to approve asphalt overlay on Swan Street not to exceed \$40,000. Second Danderson.
