



RULES AND REGULATIONS

FEBRUARY 21-24, 2019

1. All entries **MUST** have a valid Vermont Fishing License. All VT F&W rules and regulations must be followed or entry will be immediately disqualified.

1a. Only 2 NORTHERN PIKE per day can be entered.

1b. Only 2 PERCH per day can be entered, minimum length of 8"

Only 1 PERCH can be entered for the duration of the Derby to-ward the 4-wheeler.

2. All fish **MUST** be fresh and weighed in at Wright's Sport Shop: Thursday 6 AM to 7 PM, Friday 6 AM to 7 PM, Saturday 6 AM to 6 PM, (With the exception of **Saturday Absolutely NO WEIGH-INS FOR ADULTS BETWEEN 3 TO 5:30 PM** due to the Youth Derby.) and Sunday at the Elks Club 8 AM to noon. Tournament ends at noon February 24th. You must be in the Elks Club Yard by noon Sunday and prizes will be awarded at approximately 2 PM.
3. If there is a tie in a fish category the winner will be determined by length.
4. A fish can only be entered in one category.
5. **NO BASS** will be allowed in the **ADULT DERBY!**
6. Per State of Vermont Regulations, live fish can not be transported to the weigh station.
7. **YOUTH DERBY:** ALL fish to be weighed in by 4p.m. with awards to follow. Regular derby weigh-in's to start back up at 5:30p.m. and end promptly at 6 p.m.
8. Management of Wright's Sport Shop has final say on all weights and entries.

LAKES & PONDS: Big Averill, Big Salem, Caspian, Crystal, Echo, Little Averill, Little Salem, Maidstone, Memphremagog, Seymour, Shadow, Willoughby, Brownington, Carmi & Nelson, Clyde, Derby, Harvey's, Island Pond, Joes, Norton, Peacham and Wallace.

FISH CATEGORIES: Salmon, Rainbow Trout, Lake Trout, Brown Trout, Walleye, Northern Pike & Perch. (No bass allowed in the adult derby.)

MINIMUM LENGTHS: Lake Trout 24", Salmon 20", Rainbow & Brown Trout 20", Northern Pike 28", Walleye 18" and Yellow Perch 8"
