As you read this, the new Aerie is celebrating its one year anniversary. There have been a few rough spots over the past year but we have come through with a fully functioning Aerie. Everyone needs to take a little time to say a word of thanks to the volunteers who have tirelessly worked thousands of hours to get the Aerie open, maintained, and running. The move and subsequent opening of our new building has cost the Puyallup Eagles around \$300,000 out of our own pocket. This is not due to any one entity but several and includes items not covered by Sound Transit, fees and requirements levied by the City of Puyallup, lawyers, and upgrades to our new building. Again, this number would be much higher if not for the volunteers who did the work and who are doing the work to make your experience at the Eagles the best it can be. While the Aerie may not have all of the amenities yet of the old facility, one thing holds true, it is all ours. Aerie 2308 does not owe a dime to any creditor or government agency. There are several Aeries that are on the verge of closing down due to debt they have accumulated and cannot repay.

As we enter our next year, we hope to begin Bingo, limited bands with dancing, and more restaurant activity. Through the summer we will be having food trucks on site at various times for dinner options.

The Trustees would like to encourage all members to attend Aerie and Auxiliary meetings. At the member meetings you can learn and understand how the Aerie and Auxiliary function, learn about the finances and business of the Aerie and Auxiliary, and maybe win a raffle or drawing.
