**RULES & REGULATIONS**

- **Entry Fee:** \$8.00  
*(Entry fee will be deducted from winners only)*
- Boys and girls 8 to 19 years of age as of 1/1/24 who live in Warren, Henderson, Mercer, McDonough, Fulton and Knox counties are eligible to enter.
- **All exhibitors 19 & under who enter 4 or more projects will receive a FREE PASS for the Grandstand Event Friday Night.**
- **Check in time for exhibits is 7:30 – 9:00 a.m.**
- The building will be closed at 9:00 a.m. for judging and no late entries can be accepted.
- All Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, and made during the current year.
- “Top Awards” will be given to the top exhibits in Food, Clothing, Home Arts, Handicrafts.
- **EXHIBITORS ARE LIMITED TO TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS. (EXCEPT ARTS P-M 835-851 - 1 PER CLASS)**
- Not responsible for accidents or breakage.
- All items will be judged in the category in which the exhibitor has placed them. No exceptions.
- Superintendents’ and judges’ decisions are final.
- All entries will be on display until 7:00 p.m. in the shelter house. Projects are to be picked up between 7–8 p.m. Exhibitors unable to pick up exhibits should make alternate arrangements. Any unclaimed entries will be discarded.

- **Premium checks may be picked up at the fair office on Saturday, July 20, after 6:00 p.m. If you can not make it at this time please make other arrangements.**  
If you would like your check mailed, you must bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Fair Office the day of your event.

**FOODS**

- Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class in Dept. P-O.
- All baked foods should be on **HEAVY CARDBOARD TRAYS OR FOAM PLATES**, and covered with clear plastic ziplock bags. Attach entry tag securely to the bag. **BOXES MAY BE USED FOR CAKES.**
- Name of recipes with ingredient list **MUST** be included. Recipe instructions not needed.
- Each exhibit must be prepared from a different recipe, per person, per family.
- Bring whole product except where stated: (Ex: 12 cookies)

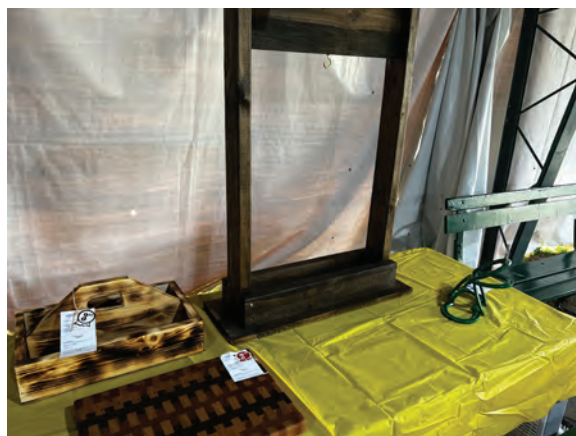
