Pastor's thoughts ...

Hello St. Mark's Lutheran,

Let's start out the newsletter this month with a daily devotion I do from time to time. Today's comes from 1 **Thessalonians 5:16-19**, "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit." Where does this reading take you?

Well, the summer is a great time to gather with family and friends. It's a time to take that vacation we've been meaning to... time to relax/decompress/be restored. Reconnecting with friends and family around a campfire, out fishing, or going to a theme park/fair I think is part of our collective story. But as we get older circumstances can change, distance can make visiting harder, and losing loved ones becomes part of our reality. With Elyse about to start back to school and a few funerals of late, I suppose my mind wandered to loneliness as I read from Thessalonians. How do we navigate loneliness after a loss?

One of the most painful human emotions is loneliness. There are times when being alone is unavoidable. But beloved, God has sent His Spirit to live within us, we are never truly on our own. The Holy Spirit—our advocate, our helper (John 14:26)—is with us every second of every day.

And thankfully, the Spirit of God helps us in our prayer life. First, He prods us to pray. Have you ever felt a strong sense that you needed to spend time with the Lord—perhaps without even knowing why? That is the Spirit convicting you. After all, the Spirit knows when we need strength because of an imminent difficulty, and sometimes encourages us to confess sin so our fellowship with the Father isn't hindered.

Second, the Holy Spirit intercedes for us. There are times when we do not know how to pray—for example, when sorrow or helplessness overwhelms us to the point that words are impossible to speak, when all we can do is cry to Jesus. Then the Spirit will lead on our behalf.

What a privilege to have God's Spirit dwelling in your heart. Do you recognize His power and love throughout your day? He longs to comfort, enable, and guide you each and every moment.

So I hope that your summer was a good one, full of visits with friends and family, and maybe even some times of self-reflection. I hope that if you have been experiencing feelings of loneliness, that you feel God's presence, comfort, and support. And that you know, that your St. Mark's Lutheran family is here to walk with you too. St. Mark's is a fantastic place full of fantastic people and when we come together to share our connectedness and our loneliness, our hopes and dreams, our triumphs and failures, our joy and sorrow I truly believe that God works through the body of this church. Looking forward to an amazing Autumn season with you.
