Trip Highlights for June 2020

June TGIF at Carolina Crab Company



Since Covid-19 the ski club has been staying home like everyone else, however on June 12th we decided to hold our first TGIF since March. We had 21 people attend at the Carolina Crab Company in Palmetto Bay Marina. Drinks and fun were had by all.

We plan on holding our next two TGIF's in July and August. They will be at Mangiamo's and then Street Meet. Both venues have outdoor seating for us. Mangiamo's has a large porch to the right of their restaurant where we will be located. Street Meet has a large verandah in front of their restaurant.

On August 30th we hope to have the Ski Club picnic at Spring Lake. IF the weather holds up there are numerous seats outside. We still must get an ok for our group size based on Covid-19 limitations.

2021 Cruising
7 Day Mexican Riviera aboard the Koningsdam
January 9th-16th, 2021 Round Trip from San Diego



At this time, this cruise is still scheduled.

Come join the fun on a 7 Day cruise leaving from San Diego on January 7th aboard the Koningsdam which we sailed on to Norway. This will take us to Cabo San Lucas, Puerto Vallarta, and Mazatlan Mexico.

We already have 10 people signed up for this trip. Pricing starts at \$899.00 for an outside cabin.

2021 Ski Trip

February 20th-27th at the Steamboat Grand Hotel



As of now 14 people have signed up for Steamboat. I need at least 3 more people to sign up to ensure our contract is met. We have to guarantee \$10,000 in revenue to Steamboat by July 31st.

Remember, you can cancel at any time up until December 1st. In addition if Covid-19 is still an issue by February we can cancel the entire thing with no penalty.

Our trip to Steamboat is all set for next year. I have reserved 10 queen hotel rooms and 2 King hotel rooms as well as 4 two-bedroom condos which have one king and two queen beds. This is setup for 40 people.

Pricing is as follows:

We will be staying at the Steamboat Grand Hotel which is located right on the slopes with ski- in/ski-out. The hotel offers 328 luxury hotel rooms as well as one, two- and three-bedroom condos and penthouses.

Amenities include a full-service fitness center, full-service spa, outdoor heated pool, complimentary internet, daily housekeeping, complimentary transportation within the city limits, and complimentary slope-side ski/snowboard storage.
