

The actual cost to educate a child at Our Lady Star of the Sea School is approximately \$9,500 per year. Our tuition rates are as follows:

CATHOLIC ACTIVE PARISHIONER GRANT:

The Catholic Active Parishioner Grant of \$1,200 per student will be awarded to families who meet the following criteria:

- The student and at least one parent/guardian must be a Catholic in good standing with the Church.
- The family must be registered and participating members of a Catholic parish.
- Participation means that the family is responsible for attending weekly Sunday Mass with their student(s) at the parish in which they are registered and must contribute their time, talent, and treasure to support the life of the Parish.
- Families must submit the <u>Verification of Catholic Eligibility form</u>.

FINANCIAL AID:

TUITION PAYMENTS:

- Tuition billing and payments are processed through TADS.
- Payments are made over **10 months**, with a choice of payment plans.
- Tuition payments are due by the 10th of the month; first payment is due July 10th.
- Payments are made electronically through TADS.
- In the event that it becomes necessary for OLSS to institute legal proceedings to collect tuition, the parent/guardian financially responsible for tuition will be responsible for all legal/attorney fees, courts costs, and any fees associated with collections agencies.
