***Viburnum 'Blue Muffin' All Sizes*** -Creamy white summer flowers are followed by blue fruit in late summer. Chicago Lustre is a good pollinator. May be trimmed after flowering (leave flowers for fall berries.) Native. Deer resistant. Fruit is good for birds



***Euonymus alatus Compactus-#3 & #7*** -'Compactus' is a popular burning bush cultivar. It is a deciduous shrub which is not all that "compact" since it typically grows in a mound to 10' tall with a slightly larger spread, though it can easily be kept shorter by pruning.



***Abelia 'Kaleidoscope' #3***-Bright, golden yellow variegation on medium green leaves along with brilliant red stems create a striking kaleidoscope of color. A low, compact selection for that works well as a foundation plant, low hedge, in patio containers, or as a ground cover

***Delosperma 'FireSpinner' #2***-Stunning tri-colored flowers cover a tight, fast spreading mat of succulent evergreen foliage. Prolific blooms in spring, reblooming throughout summer. Apple-green foliage keeps its shiny presence through winter. A hardy, heat-loving, non-invasive ground cover



***Delosperma cooperi #2***

Vibrant purplish pink 2-inch flowers cover the fleshy green foliage over a very long period. Heat, drought and salt tolerant, this adaptable plant thrives with little care, even in rocky, unimproved soils. Non-invasive.



***Veronica Royal Candles*** -Expect a profusion of vibrant, violet-blue flower spikes over an exceptionally long season from this easy to grow perennial. Upright, neat and compact habit



***Miscanthus Gracillimus #7*** 'Gracillimus', known as maiden grass, is noted for its narrow green leaves with a silver midrib which form a substantial, rounded, arching clump of foliage typically growing 4-6' tall (to 8' when in flower). Foliage turns yellowish after frost, but quickly fades to straw-beige by winter.



***Atilbe 'Fanal'***— Showy perennial for beautiful summer color in shady areas. Tall, feathery blooms of deep garnet red valued for light, airy quality, rise above bronze-green foliage. Thrives in dappled or full-shade borders. Gorgeous in massed plantings.
