To All Gift Aid Donors of St Anne's Westby. Following the end of the current tax year on 5th April a tax refund claim will be made on the individual Gift Aid donations made by our parishioners since 6th April 2018. The claim will be submitted to HM Revenue & Customs by the Diocese amounting to 25% of all such donations. As a registered charity the Diocese qualifies for this valuable concession allowed by the Government on charitable donations. The tax refund will be passed from the Diocese to the Parish. It is most important that each donor limits his or her Gift Aid contribution in the tax year as a whole to not more than the amount of tax paid or payable. Any donor ceasing to be a tax payer must inform The Gift Aid Administrator, Alastair Eccles, as soon as possible either after Sunday Mass or by phoning 07725 878555; and the Parish welcomes any new Gift Aid donors who as tax payers can enable the Parish to receive an extra 25% of their contributions at no cost to themselves.
