ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY GUIDED TOUR



How did the 1,200-acre plantation belonging to George Washington's grandson, become the home to the most famous, though not the largest of all the U.S. military cemeteries? Come walk with us through the 625-acre memorial to those gallant men and women who have served. The tour spotlights little-known facts as well as historical data about this significant cemetery. We will stop at the Kennedy gravesite, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and several key headstones of those with unique stories to tell in our history. Join Carla Smith, Level member and DC professional tour guide on **September 24**, **2016 from 12:30pm - 3:30pm**. Cost: **\$16 per person**. A minnimum of 20 participants is necessary for the tour to commence as scheduled. Maximum number of participants: 25 persons. Tour participants will meet at the visitors center at the entry to Arlington Cemetery.

VIRGINIA WINERY TOUR AND TASTING: GRAPES TO GLASS TOUR

Located in Middleburg VA, Greenhill Winery has created some of the best wines in Virginia since opening their doors. They even had a Viognier that the first lady enjoyed so much that she insisted they serve it at a state dinner. Participants will get an inside look into Greenhill's wine making practices utilizing 100% Virginia grown grapes. From viticulture to vinification, learn how each step in the process culminates into the flavors experienced in the glass. The tour culminates with a full tasting of their current selection of wines.

Sunday October 23, 2016; 10:00am participants will meet at Level to be transported to Middleburg, VA. The tour will be two hours with opportunity for participants to shop or relax amongst the scenic background of the winery. Bus will return to Level by 2pm. Cost: **\$75 per person**, includes
