





Highlights



Completed 28 search-andrescue cases; saving 20 lives and assisting 27 others. Logged over 350 flight hours from FOL Kotzebue.





Conducted multiple exercises and trainings including Operation Arctic Guardian, an oil spill seminar and equipment deployment in Utqiagʻvik, Alaska.

Visited 9 remote villages with deployed cutters; hosting 102 people for tours and reaching over 700 people about boating safety.



Visited 41 remote villages


