PARSONAGE RENOVATION

The Administrative Church Council unanimously voted on March 18 to move forward with the parsonage project. The project cost will range from \$100,000.00 up to \$150,000.00. Although it is expected to

finish closer to the low end of the range, we want to be sure the project is fully funded without the need to incur any debt as there may be unforeseen cost overruns.

The initial \$100,000.00 will come from current church cash reserves. The hope (expectation of answered prayer) is that the balance will come in through the generous giving of our church family. Many people have already expressed an interest in getting behind this project and the Council is very confident this financial need will be met.
