

The I & S Committee met for its monthly meeting and looked over the financial health of the church. Traditionally, giving goes down during the summer months.

OH BOY! WE NEED TO TALK TO THE CONGREGATION!

Our goal is to always be transparent to you. We started 2023 with a nice healthy balance of \$74,034.79. This looks good on paper, but this balance was the result of having a half-time pastor for a year and a half and very little programming all during the pandemic. Our full-time pastor began in July 2022. We have also been catching up with repairs to the manse and church. As you can see from the figures below, receipts have not kept up with our receipts this year. The 2023 budget is \$140,193. The average monthly amount needed to support the budget is \$11,681.

Okay, enough gloom and doom! We encourage you to give what you can during the summer months. Remember the church still operates all year.
