



## HOW TO VOTE IN THE 2019 PH MID-TERM ELECTIONS

1. Overseas Voting will commence on 13 April 2019 at 9:00 am PST and will continue until 13 May 2019 at 3:00 am PST.

2. The mode of voting for those under the jurisdiction of the Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver is Postal Voting (Automated Election System).

3. Ballots will be mailed to the respective addresses of registered voters found in the Certified List of Overseas Voters (CLOV). Click or copy the link below to check your name on the CLOV:

4. Voters may mail back or personally submit their accomplished ballots sealed using the COMELEC-provided envelope and paper seal. The deputized Special Ballot Reception and Custody Group (SBRCG) at the Consulate will be available to receive accomplished ballots during the following dates/times:

April 13, 2019, First Day	9:00 am - 5:00 pm
April 14 – 30, 2019	9:00 am - 5:00 pm
May 1 – 11, 2019	9:00 am - 5:00 pm
May 12, 2019	9:00 am – 11:59 pm
May 13, 2019, Last Day	12:00 midnight – 3:00 am

5. All registered voters are welcome to observe the feeding of the ballots to the Vote Counting Machines (VCMs) on the following Mondays and Thursdays, from 9:00 am, at the Consulate's Reception Area, 660-999 Canada Place, Vancouver, B.C., V6C 3E1, Canada:
