Things That Will Help You Grow Spiritually

- 1. LIVE and WORK** to reach others each day as if you knew the world was going to come to an end next Sunday night. Think of that feeling of urgency and priority! (II Peter 3:1-12).
- 2. BE AS ENTHUSIASTIC** about the church and its services as you would be if there were overflowing crowds each time. Think of the interest, anticipation, and excitement of an overflowing crowd! (Psalm 122:1)
