DESCRIPTION: For those who like really old English long bows, here is an interesting one. Riser appears to be made of Lemonwood. A new home-made leather grip has been added. There are black inlays on the tips. This was a company (perhaps York) made bow as the specs are stamped into the riser. There is no arrow shelf. You will need to either shoot off a glove or get a stick-on rest. Limbs are straight. Tips are in good condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. No decal or other markings other than the specs. Still a shooter after all these years.
