DIRECTIONS:

From Southern California Hwy 14 north to Hwy 138 west to LaPetite (about 25 miles) turn right go to where pavement makes a sharp right turn and becomes Elise St, continue to end of pavement and turn right on B-8 (line of mailboxes on the corner) continue to Calcot and make left turn, house on left.

From Northern California take 5 Fwy south to Hwy 138 east to LaPetite, turn left and follow above directions.
