LET'S TALK TRASH

Several neighbors have opted out of the HOA sponsored contract with Waste Connections. That means different trucks are going through Bay Hills each week. That also

means Waste Connections drivers CANNOT assume you are their customer UNLESS you use the FREE large blue bin they provide. Even if you have little trash to put out, PLEASE use the big blue rolling bin.

[Editor's note: even after 34 yrs as customer, our trash was skipped because of no big blue bin. We have one now!] Call Waste Connections Customer Service to request one: 727-572-6800

In NO case is it okay to put out bags of food trash (not in a closed bin). That draws rats, raccoons, possums and birds, often resulting in garbage strewn around the street.

One last reminder: our Deed Restriction #7 requires that trash bins be hidden from view when not at curb for trash pick up day.
