


TRADITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT AND APPLICATION



The Open-Gate Foundation and Fernley STEM Council traditional scholarship will be awarded to the Fernley High School senior who best meets the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship Award amount is \$500.00.

The Scholarship Committee will review and score all submitted and complete applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone. The Scholarship Committee may choose to interview applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified by June 1, 2018.

Scholarships are open to **graduating high school seniors**. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name.

Student applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Plan to attend an accredited trade school, college or university on a part-time or full time basis.
- 2. Must have a high school Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Must have acquired acceptance to the school of his/her choice.

All applications and supporting documents must be received or postmarked no later than April 30, 2018. If submitting electronically, applications must be submitted by 5:00pm Pacific Time.

3. Attach additional sheets as needed in order to complete questions 2-5. (Not to exceed one page per question.)

- 4. Applications must include the following:
 - Complete Application form, including essay
 - Three references with complete contact information for each (on application form)
 - An unofficial copy of your most recent high school transcript
- 5. Applications must be received by **April 30, 2018.** <u>THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS</u>. If choosing to mail (electronic submission info is in #2), mail completed applications to:
