Dear Sirs,

The Tennessee Federation of Fire Chaplains (TFFC) is in the process of building three Rehab Support Units and seeks to place them in service across the State of Tennessee. Each of these units will provide a mobile restroom facility with plenty of space to doff and don protective equipment and will provide it in a climate-controlled environment. These Rehab Support Trailers can be pulled to disaster scenes, multiple alarm events, and extended duration emergencies. They may also be used for emergency service personnel at large public events as well.

Each unit will have an on-board generator, potable water tank, toilet, point-of-use water heater, hand-washing sink, emergency eyewash station, wastewater tank, heat, air conditioning, and room for storage. These extended-height trailers are built on 6'x10' frames with trailer brakes and will be easy to pull with a simple six-pin round electrical connection and a 2" trailer hitch ball. We would like to have one centrally located in each of the three Tennessee Emergency Management Agency Grand Divisions (East, Middle, and West). The TFFC will retain ownership, but will make them fully available to TEMA and all emergency service agencies across the state.

The Tennessee Federation of Fire Chaplains is currently accepting letters of application from emergency service oriented companies that would like to sponsor these units. The materials for each of the three units cost \$9000 (far less than \$15,000 for one commercially produced restroom trailer). These units will provide an excellent opportunity for your agency to make a statewide statement of support and interest toward the emergency service personnel of Tennessee.

We will provide your agency with a proportional amount of space corresponding with your sponsorship along with the Tennessee Federation of Fire Chaplains as the provider. Members of the TFFC will provide design, construction, maintenance, deployment, and training. The host agency, at their discretion, may offer an organizational logo to go on each side as well.

The TFFC plans to present these trailers to TEMA and representatives of the destination agencies at a dedication service to be announced. Follow-up presentations at emergency service leadership conferences and the destination locations will also occur.
