Contest format:

- ❖ Please submit an original work of at least 2 pages – no more than 5
- ❖ Correct spelling and grammar will count too!
- ❖ Your title page must include the name and grade of the student, the title and author of the book that inspired the work, as well as a sample of the original author’s writing style (a photo copy of one of the original pages)
- ❖ Explain what you are changing and why
- ❖ Submit to Milton Free Public Library (or Nute School Library) before February 7th

Winners will be announced Thursday, February 20 at the Nute High School “Nute Week” Festivities. This contest is open to all Milton high school students.
