

Hiddenbrook Homes Association 2013 Year in Review

Greetings Neighbors! As we look ahead to actions and activities being conducted by the Hiddenbrook HOA, let's look back at some of the many items, from finances to the clubhouse, that were completed in 2013. These are just a few highlights of the many items that were accomplished.

Relative to finances, monies were moved between banks and accounts to garner a higher interest rate and meet FDIC thresholds. Also, our reserve accounts were supplemented and are currently 100% funded.

We continued to develop standard procedures and forms for our facility (e.g., a feedback form for pool members, a facility incident report, the clubhouse rental contract, pool rules,...). We also revised our Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Guidelines, developed an ARC Activity Log and addressed some pipeline issues and concerns by clarifying the clubhouse facility boundaries and ownership demarcation.

The Mainstream Newsletter and flash emails were sent to subscribers throughout the year as we continually strive to maintain and improve good communication within our community. In addition, the Hiddenbrook Facebook page was introduced in 2013 and our Hiddenbrook website was revamped and updated on a consistent basis. Our Hiddenbrook neighborhood directory was updated, and made available electronically or via hard copy upon request.

Our clubhouse facility "club room" received some badly needed attention. If you haven't been by to visit the facility, you will be pleased to see the many transformations that have taken place. Particularly noteworthy is the "club room". It has been painted along with the kitchen, foyer and upstairs bathroom. The foyer banister was refinished and the treads on the foyer stairs were replaced. The old HVAC bulkhead was removed to improve energy efficiency and light fixtures were added. Many overdue repairs were addressed and completed during the painting and refurbishment activities.

Moving downstairs to the pool areas, some of the most noticeable items completed were replacing the old plastic Dri Deck flooring with porcelain tile floors and rubber mats, the installation of better lighting and replacement of shower stall curtains and accessories. These changes will help us maintain a cleaner facility for our members.

The pool was another item that received some badly needed attention. It was re-caulked, retiled along the racing lanes, and re-surfaced. A new sound system was installed along with the implementation of a pool music policy.


A Message From The

Architecture Review Committee

With Spring approaching, we know that often means taking on exterior projects around our homes. We want to remind everyone that most architectural changes to the exterior of your home require prior approval. This can include but is not limited to: installing new siding, roofing, doors, windows, fencing and decks as well as changing the colors of your trim, shutters, gutters or front door, and removing trees. We have worked to make information easy to obtain through our website www.hiddenbrookhomes.org regarding the process and specifics on what is, and isn't, permitted. You can also easily print the guidelines and application from the website.

As was mentioned in the August 2013 Mainstream, new ARC guidelines have been drafted. They are currently under review by our attorneys, and after they are returned to us, they will be posted to the website and time will be set aside most likely in the March or April Board meeting for homeowner input; we will make an announcement in advance. The new guidelines will also be more encompassing to include the responsibility of each of us as homeowners to *maintain* our homes. As the weather warms, please take a good look at your property and home. Do the shutters or wood trim need a fresh coat of paint? Is your siding green from algae and in need of a power wash? Are your gutters, siding, shutters securely attached to your home? Are the bushes overgrown or does your landscaping need some 'freshening up'? Once the guidelines have been approved by the board and provided to the community, the ARC committee will begin the process of inspecting all homes and enforcing the new guidelines. It is our hope that everyone emerges from this cold and snowy winter with a renewed ambition to take care of their homes and do their part to keep our community looking nice!
