We worked with Fresh Cut on this project which was completed 2 months ago. The sprinkler system has been improved, dead bushes removed and colorful annuals planted on the east and west sides. Last, mulch was put down.

Earlier this year the lighting fixture was fixed at the South Entrance and dead shrubs removed.

Our next project will be working on the Podocarpus along Jolly Roger creating our natural wall of healthy plants. The goal is a 6 ft. height and we're almost there! It has been too hot as we are waiting for cooler weather to remove the unhealthy ones and replace.

We also use the dues for our Garage Sales, (advertising), and our 2 Outings in the Spring and Fall for all residents to partake in, (food, rental of Pavilion etc.).


We have gone green this year and that has been a large savings to HOA and a much better means of communicating with all residents who wish and can partake.



On Wednesday April 28, the Thomas family suffered a catastrophic house fire in their Satellite Beach home. All family members are safe and in good health, but the fire destroyed the house. While the fire dept. was able to stop the fire before the house became fully engulfed in flames, there is tremendous smoke damage inside, the windows are all broken out and a large hole was cut in the roof during the process. The home is uninhabitable at this time. Without knowing the reasons, and not needing to, the family did not have homeowner's insurance. The family owns the home and is devastated. There are 2 adults and 6 children (ranging in age from 2-18) who have had their life upended and it is not yet known if the home is salvageable. The 8 of them are staying in a local family member's home at this time and the immediate needs are not yet fully understood. 100% of the proceeds from this fundraiser will go to the family and help in their path to recovery, whether it is rebuilding this home or relocating to a new one.

Happy Spring Friends and Neighbors,

Well, the weather is finally starting to feel like spring. I believe that our spring community garage sale was a success as many houses had sales. If you were one of them, I sincerely hope that you were successful selling unwanted treasures.

April was going to be the first going green newsletter with every resident getting this valuable document via email. We have postponed the "going live" date to May 1st because we have not collected all of the resident's email addresses.

To date, we have 137 resident email addresses. That leaves 71 of the Moorings residents who haven't responded to our request for their email address.

I believe that there are a couple of reasons for this. One could be that a resident does not have access to email because of infirmity or lack of computer access. These residents should be in the minority and if we are aware, we will have paper copies delivered to their home. The second reason could be security. I understand not wanting one's email splattered all over the place however, I can reassure everyone that their email, if noted, will not be published in our directory or given out to anyone and will only be used for the newsletter.

So, where does that leave us? Well, if you have received with this newsletter, a form requesting your email, please respond and let us know if you want to provide it or if you are without email due to the reasons I stated. Just please be aware, after May 1st. you will either be emailed a newsletter or have one delivered because you have no access or are too infirm. For those that do not share their email and are not infirm, you can always get your newsletter by logging on to the Moorings website.
