During your visit you might want to observe the following:

1. Does your child choose work freely, concentrate, complete the task, clean his/her work area, and replace the work where he/she found it?
2. What materials or activities does your child choose?
3. How does your child select his/her work?
4. How long did your child stay with the activity? Did he/she repeat the activity?
5. In what ways does your child communicate to others?
 - ~verbalization

 - ~observation
 - ~eye contact
6. How does your child respond to the ground rules of the classroom?
7. Do you see a demonstration of:
 - ~independence
 - ~self-discipline
 - ~respect
 - ~confidence
 - ~self-sufficiency
