



PENINSULA RUN ~ Rocky Mount, MO

Here's what you need to know...

The Camp Sabra race will be unique – the camp is a peninsula, nearly an island. That means there are many areas of the trail that run right along the lake shore of Lake of the Ozarks. A good guess is that half or more of the big bike track is within sight of the water.

There has never been a race here before so you're looking at a 100% new/virgin trail. The big bike track for Saturday and Sunday morning is 5.2 miles and we have an additional section to add in for the Sunday afternoon race making that course 6.1 miles.

Notice the name of the town is "Rocky Mount"...that's pretty accurate. The terrain is gravelly/rocky and there are lots of ups and downs. It's almost certain that the side knobs on your tires will get just as much use as the center knobs. In addition to the rocks and hills, expect a few log crossings...since this property got logged recently there will be a few leftovers. The big ones are gone but there will be a few to test your log hopping ability.

The 50 track is mostly separate from any of the other courses. Their course meanders through the obstacle course so there are some unique things to weave in and out of on their trail. Remember – green ribbon, orange/black arrows is what the 50 riders need to follow...and watch the signs!!

65/85/Ladies follow purple ribbon, orange/black arrows & watch the signs! They have plenty of their own trail and unique features to ride near and through. A good guess is that the track is a couple miles, although one section may or may not be 85/Ladies only...still deciding on that one. Just know that the track weaves through cabins, down some steps, crosses two bridges, runs along the beach, and through the archery shack...in addition to some sweet fresh single track. Oh yeah – down the hill with the zip line overhead. Where else can you get that?

Big bike uniqueness – along the edge of the ball field, through Todd's yard, weave through some cabins and the shower house, between the dining hall and the scenic lookout, around the waterslide, through a couple more "yards", and they get the bridge, the beach and the archery shack too. Oh yeah – almost forgot about running past the amphitheater.

The parking will be a little spread out so please keep that in mind and park "friendly".

Nicest bathrooms/showers you will ever find at a dirt bike race.

The scoring trailer is parked under a pavilion near the basketball court.

Everyone starts in the same place – next to the ball field.

Support the concession stand – please & thank you!
