William D. Evans II is the founder and president of Poly-Tech Associates, Inc. With business offices in Cleveland and Akron, Ohio, Mr. Evans offers expertise as a certified polygraphist, educator and attorney. Poly-Tech was founded in 1977 to provide forensic polygraph services to defense or prosecuting attorneys; Mr. Evans worked as a Detective for the Summit County Sheriff's Office before launching his private company.

Mr. Evans is a neutral expert, with law enforcement agencies, defense, and prosecuting attorneys forming his client base. He earned his B.S., M.S., and J.D. from The University of Akron. He has served as adjunct faculty in the Department of Criminal Justice, The University of Akron. Evans was first certified at the National Training Center of Polygraph Science, later trained for computerized polygraph testing at the Department of Defense Polygraph Institute and is currently certified by the American Polygraph Association for criminal specific issue testing and post-conviction sex offender testing. Mr. Evans was the first to use a computerized polygraph instrument in the state of Ohio; the first in Ohio and 4th in the nation to employ Ocular Lie detection and the first in the country known to combine the two technologies, thereby achieving an Outcome Confidence Interval (OCI).

Evans' career spans four decades with case work heavily concentrated in criminal cases and law enforcement investigative examinations, several of which received national attention. Evans frequently serves as an expert witness relating to polygraph and has testified as an expert witness in federal, state, and local courts.

An accomplished speaker and author, he lectures nationally and internationally on the topic of nonverbal communications and polygraph. At the request of the US Army JAG and Trial Defense Services, he spoke in Dresden Germany.
