San Diegans who left us in 2019 Judy McCarty, 78 - March 4

She served a decade and a half on the San Diego City Council and was instrumental in developing Mission Trails Regional Park.

She and her husband, Curt, moved in the 1970s to San Diego, making their home in the shadow of Cowles Mountain. Almost immediately, she began volunteering with her community planning group. Soon, she was elected chairwoman. When the 7th District City Council seat opened, she went for it. First sworn in to the San Diego City Council in 1985, McCarty was returned to City Hall three times and served a total of 15 years before retiring from elected office. Her public service did not end with her last council term.

She was active in Republican Party leadership. Over the years, she hosted U.S. Secretary of State James Baker, Second Lady Marilyn Quayle, Vice President candidate Jack Kemp, and four sitting governors, and she collaborated with other national leaders.

Note from RWCNC: Judy McCarty was long-term member of our club and served as President and several other roles throughout the years. She is loved and missed!
