October 1, 2019

1. Chairman Robert Parker called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present; Vice – Chairman Clifton Deloach, Commissioner Michael Riddle, Commissioner David Richardson and Commissioner Michael Phillips. Also, in attendance was County Clerk Mary Ann Odum and County Attorney James Smith.
2. Commissioner Riddle led the invocation.
3. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioners.
4. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle to approve the October Agenda. Commissioner Phillips seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
5. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle to approve the September 2019 Minutes. Commissioner Phillips seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
6. Chairman Parker gave the Financial Report for the month of September 2019. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle to pay bills. Commissioner Phillips seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
7. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle, seconded by Commissioner Deloach to accept the lowest bid made by Poole's Framing and Roofing in the amount of \$122,000.00. The contract will include materials and labor to repair the roof at the Long County Annex Building. Commissioner Richardson opposed. The motion passed 4-1.
8. Motion made by Commissioner Phillips, seconded by Commissioner Riddle to accept the lowest bid made by Southern Landscape in the amount of \$5,550.00 to seal and stripe the courthouse parking lot. The motion passed unanimously.
9. Motion made by Commissioner Phillips, seconded by Commissioner Deloach to accept the lowest bid made by Hodges Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$5,100.00 to repair the roof of the Sheriffs Building. The motion passed unanimously.
10. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle, seconded by Commissioner Phillips to accept the lowest bid made by Hinesville Fence EBG, LLC in the amount of \$9450.00 to install fencing at the Long County Annex Building. Commissioner Richardson opposed. The motion passed 4-1.

11. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle, seconded by Commissioner Phillips to accept the Proposal of Services made by ChemPro in the amount of \$12,000.00 to be paid out of SPLOST. ChemPro will apply a custom blend of herbicide to the selected drainage ditches as directed. The motion passed unanimously.
12. Motion made by Commissioner Deloach, seconded by Commissioner Phillips to proclaim Friday, October 11, 2019 as "Pink Out Friday" to support those who are fighting breast cancer and recognition of those who have lost a loved one to this
