**TIFFANY & CO. ON LONG ISLAND BURGLARIZED
TWO MEN CAUGHT
Saturday July 11, 2015**

According to media reports, the police in Manhasset, New York, responded to an alarm signal at a Tiffany store on Northern Boulevard at approximately 4:45 am on Saturday. The responding officers found one man on the roof and another inside the building. The man on the roof had over \$1 million (mostly likely at retail value) in jewelry and watches on him.

Both men are charged with Grand Larceny, Burglary and Criminal Mischief

Crime Prevention

The information available at this point indicates the men gained entry through the roof. Further details are not yet available. It does appear that the alarm system functioned well and did the job it is supposed to do. This incident is a good reminder to check your alarm equipment. Test it periodically and review the hardware to determine if any upgrades are warranted. All alarm systems should have Line Security and a back-up method of communication.
