

A. CARS:

1. Cars with Handicap Placards: Please flash your placard at the Denton Police Officer at corner of Bonnie Brae & Windsor to turn on to Windsor. Ditto the Marcus parking attendants. Follow the **Bus – Team Drop-Off** instructions below following the red line to the **Team Drop-Off** zone. Look for handicapped spots. Spaces are limited. If none, look for open car spaces in the near lot. If none, drop off passengers and proceed to Car Parking Zone. Please ask attendants if any remaining handicap spaces.

2. Cars Dropping Off Seniors or Others Needing Special Assistance (Not Capable of Walking a Half Mile): If you don't have a Handicap Placard, but have a passenger needing special assistance (not capable of walking a half-mile), please let the Denton Police Officer at corner of Bonnie Brae and Windsor know, and the Marcus parking attendants. Follow the **Bus – Team Drop-Off** instructions below following the red line to the **Team Drop-Off** zone. Drop off your passengers and then take a right on North Lakes Park Drive and proceed to remote Car Parking Zone.

3. All Other Cars: If heading North on Bonnie Brae from 380/University Drive, please do not turn on Windsor Drive; pass Windsor and take the next right turn on to North Lakes Park Drive at [3048 N Bonnie Brae St, Denton, TX 76207](https://www.google.com/maps/place/3048+N+Bonnie+Brae+St,+Denton,+TX+76207) (click on to address to open a Google Maps Link).

4. IMPORTANT ADVICE – IF YOU DON'T WANT A TICKET: DO NOT park illegally on Windsor Drive, in front of the Goldfield Tennis Courts, the City of Denton building or on the local neighborhood streets of Parkside Drive, Bowling Green Street, North Lakes Trail, or Georgetown, etc., as the Denton Police Dept. has issued tickets to illegally parked cars in prior years. Note also that parking over the curb within the Park along North Lakes Trail, except next to the soccer field parking lot, is AT YOUR OWN RISK; over the curb parking is not sanctioned by the Denton Police Dept.
