Thursday, June 6: Quilting in the fellowship hall from 10:00-3:00. A light lunch will be served. Come and go as your schedule allows.

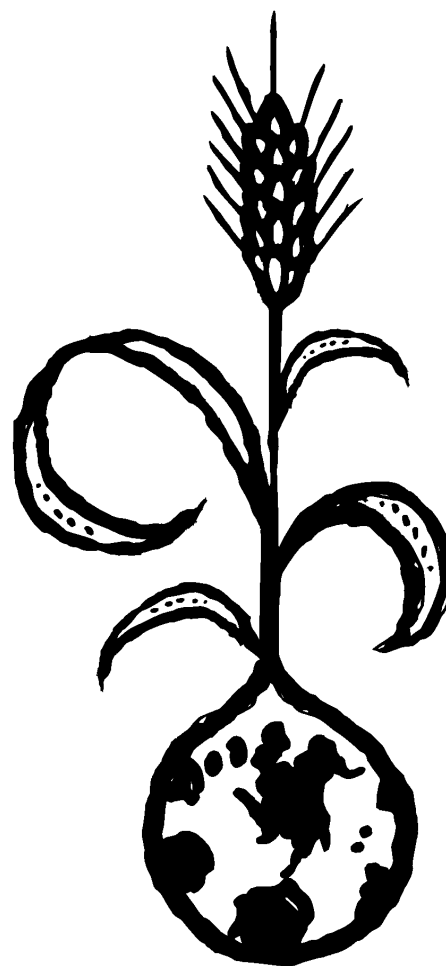
