MASS READING REFLECTION

November 28, 2021 First Reading Jer 33:14-16 [The Lord's Messiah]

"I will raise up for David a just shoot."
King David's dynasty came to a fall with
the destruction of Jerusalem by the Babylonians in 586 B.C. It was like a stump.
But from that stump God will let grow a
shoot. A new Davidic king will be on the
throne of Israel. Meanwhile, the Hebrews
were in exile in Babylon. They knew God's
promises, but were tempted to lose patience when time dragged on. Christians
see this promise fulfilled with the coming of
Jesus Christ. Then Judah, Jerusalem,
God's people, received lasting salvation.

But this salvation is only initiated in all of us. Full salvation from all evil and perfect bliss with God will be ours with Christ's final coming for you and me. When, depressed by life's tribulations, you are tempted to lose patience, make the Responsorial Psalm your prayer! "God, . . for you I wait all the day."

Second Reading 1 Thes 3:12—4:2 [Lives Pleasing to God]

The Christians of Thessalonica were waiting for Christ's return during their lifetime. Many lost patience and did not live blamelessly. Paul prays that God may strengthen their hearts, so that they may be holy at the coming of our Lord Jesus.

Advent is a time of repentance, a change of attitude, if necessary. We wait for Christ's renewed coming at Christmas and in one perspective his final coming which will be final for you or me at the moment God Calls! "Grant your faithful, we pray, almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming: (Collect).

Theme: "By Your Perseverance [Patient Endurance] You will Secure Your Lives" (Lk21:19)

The virtue of patience is not as a rule one of the strong points of people today. They want things to be done quickly and efficiently. Promises and appointments should be kept as accurately as they were made; otherwise an outburst of impatience may follow. We have all experienced the impatient and compulsive driver behind us who takes unreasonable chances and causes disaster quite often. Patients in an hospital or nursery obviously must practice the virtue of patience. They have to wait for recovery patiently and when they are old or sick for a long time they often have to wait for company or friends with even more patience.

A classic example of impatience is that of the Jews at Mount Sinai. In waiting for Moses' return from the mountain, they lost patience and constructed the golden calf. They said to Aaron: "Come, make us a god who will be our leader" (Ex 32:1).

Advent is a time of waiting for the coming of Christ. Promises have been made to us about a way out of our distress. Salvation will come, but when? We pray, but does God listen? The Advent Bible readings deal with this problem. Waiting for somebody to come, i.e., Jesus Christ, supposes patience. We must accept the human condition of "not yet" with the patient hope for better things to come.
