Front Range Hospice and Palliative Care is Different From the Rest!

We are a dedicated interdisciplinary team that feels called in our provision of end of life care, serving patients and families in their homes, in nursing homes and assisted living communities.

We feel that death is a natural process. Our philosophy at Front Range Hospice and Palliative Care is to provide dignity and respect to our patients and families during this process. These values provide the foundation of legendary care.

Our hospice staff is professionally trained in end-of life symptom management, providing comfort for both patients and their families.

Hospice care is available to the terminally ill when two physicians certify that if the terminal diagnosis runs its normal course the life expectancy is 6 months or less.



Front Range Hospice and Palliative Care is a Medicare certified hospice and a member of the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization (NHPCO). In addition we are accredited by the Joint Commission ensuring the highest standards of end of life care.

Front Range Hospice and Palliative Care provides hospice care for all patients with Medicare, Medicaid, all HMO managed Medicare programs, and some private insurances.

Hospice Services

Our focus is to allow patients to live and die in the environment of their choice. Patients may join our hospice program 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Care Team Includes:

RN Case Managers carry small case loads so each patient receives more care than is typically offered.

Certified Nurses Assistants (CNAs) assist with patient personal cares.

Clinical Social Workers provide necessary emotional support and expert information on additional resources.

Chaplains offer spiritual support and always meet the patient and families where they are in their spiritual journey.

Medications related to the hospice diagnosis and considered for comfort are 100% covered.

Volunteers are utilized for companion care, vigil requests, and other supplemental services as available.

We encourage patients to remain in the care of their **Primary Care Physicians** while they are in hospice.

Durable Medical Equipment and Supplies are provided by hospice.

Bereavement and Counseling Services

Front Range Hospice and Palliative Care is dedicated to serving the bereavement needs of all people, offering a variety of services honoring life and loss.

The hospice benefit includes bereavement services during services and up to 13 months after a loved one passes while on hospice services.

Individual Counseling, one-on-one grief counseling, is available at our office location by appointment with our Bereavement Counselor. In addition, we offer home visits and phone support to individuals and families.

Family Counseling, grief support for parents, teens and younger children. Family groups are also welcome.

We are also open to supporting different groups in the community as needed. All groups require registration. Please call our office with your inquiries.

Palliative Care Services

Nurse Practitioners will focus on symptom management, disease education, and advance care planning.

Clinical Social Workers will provide counseling on life altering disease, loss, depression, and anxiety.

Chaplains will assist with spiritual crisis and existential angst, on an as-needed basis.

Medication Reconciliation will be provided.

A **Palliative Care Certified Physician** will oversee all services provided by the Palliative Care team.

Combined Care

Colorado recognizes Community Based Palliative Care as a vital entity in the health care arena and it is governed in the regulations for Hospice. By providing both Palliative Care and Hospice Care our goal is to provide a seamless continuum of care over the course of their life threatening illness.

Focuses on relief from physical suffering. The patient may be being treated for disease or may be living with a chronic disease, and may or may not be terminally ill.

Addresses the patient's physical, mental, social, and spiritual well-being, is appropriate for patients in all disease stages, and accompanies the patient from diagnosis through optimal symptom management.

There is a cost to the patient for palliative care services. The cost is the same as specialist visit co-pay with your insurance.
