Cornus alba 'Ivory Halo' #3—
Noted for its compact size, variegated (white-edged) leaves and bright red twigs in winter



Euonymus Ala. Compactus #3—
'Compactus' is a popular burning bush cultivar. It is a deciduous shrub which is not all that "compact" since it typically grows in a mound to 10' tall with a slightly larger spread, though it can easily be kept shorter by pruning.



Juniperus hor. 'Youngstown' —
Handsome, tightly branching form creates a groundcover versatile for use in rock gardens and in the foreground of borders. Bright green foliage turns a plum color in winter.

Syringa meyeri 'Palibin' #3—
'Palibin' is a compact, low-spreading cultivar which typically grows 4-5' tall with a spread of 5-7' HEAVILY BUDDED



Hosta 'Blue Angel' #2—Blue Angel' is a giant, blue-leaved hosta that grows in a mound to 36" tall and to 48" wide.



Gaura 'Snow Fountain' #2The exceptionally long bloom time makes this an excellent choice for commercial landscapes. Masses of flowers on dense, compact plants are also useful in containers. Drought tolerant once established



Coreopsis 'Zagreb' #2— 'Zagreb' is more compact (to 1.5' tall) and features bright yellow, daisy-like flowers (1-2" diameter) with un-toothed rays and darker yellow center disks.



Festuca 'Elijah Blue' #1 & #2—
Outstanding, icy blue coloration to this clumping ornamental grass holds up even through the heat of summer



Agastache 'Blue Fortune' #2—
Full pots and budded, ready to bloom in your yards!
